**Clear and practical definitions** of the competences of rehabilitation professionals working in different cultural contexts in the field of social rehabilitation.

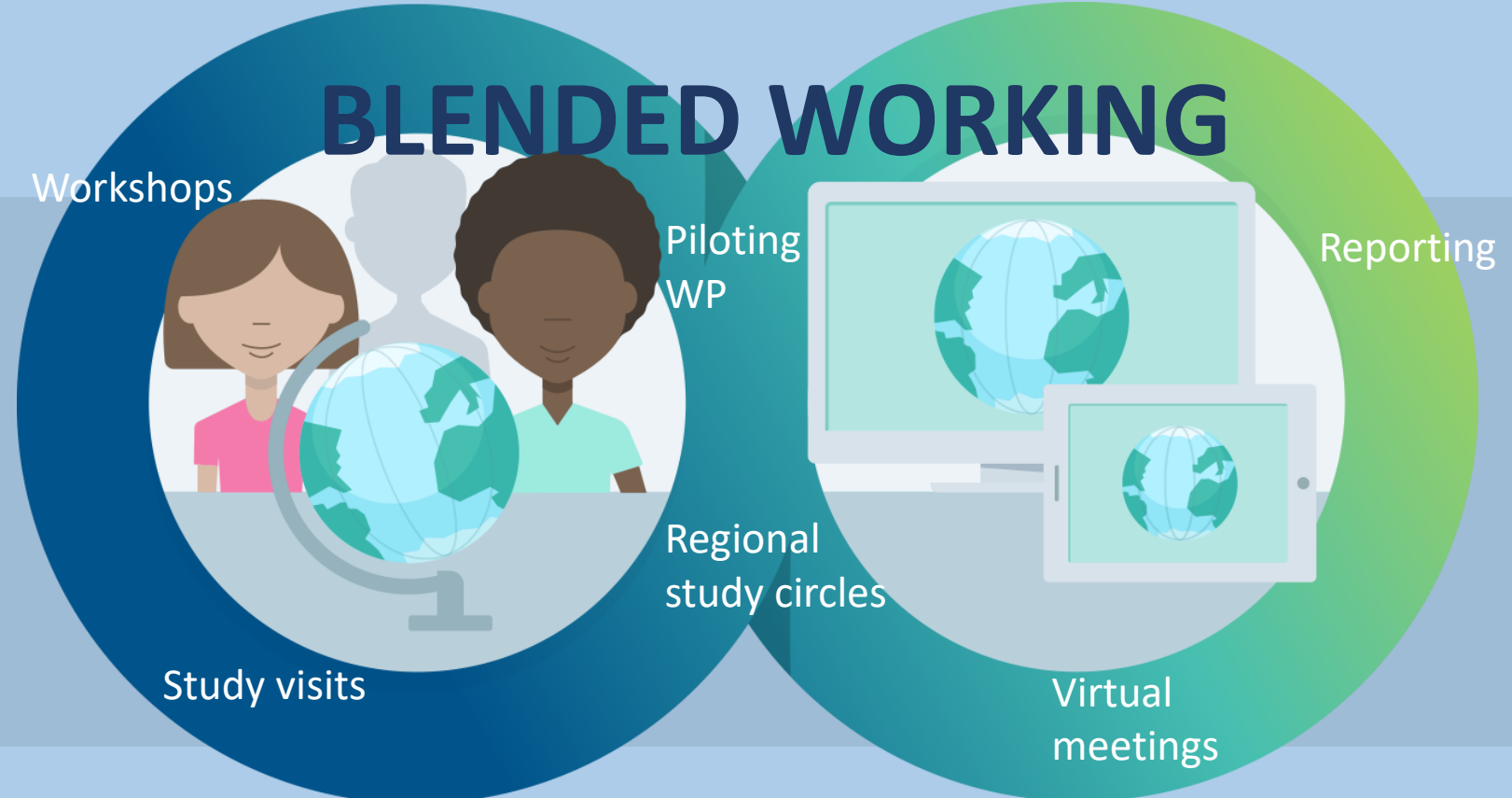
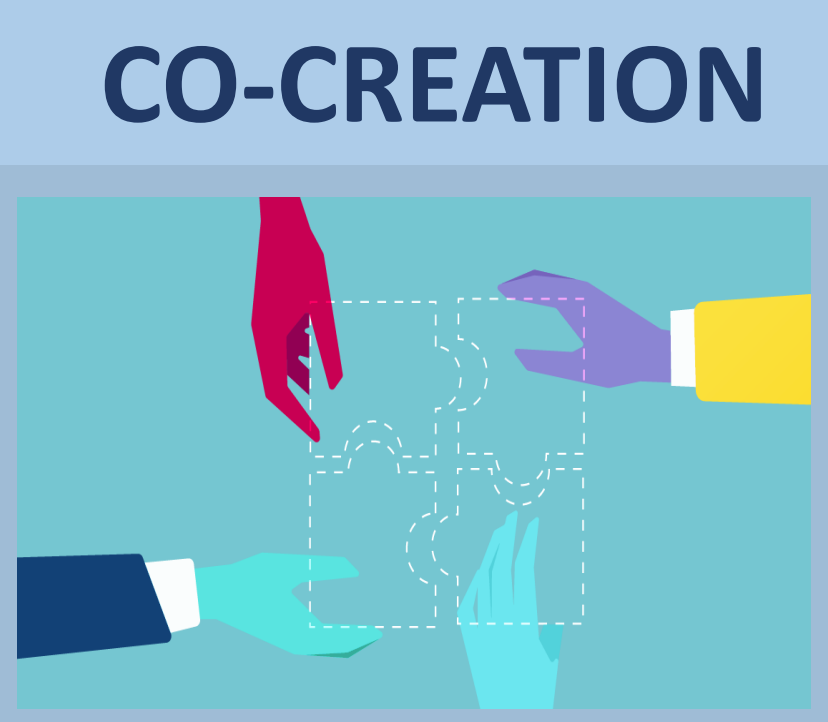
