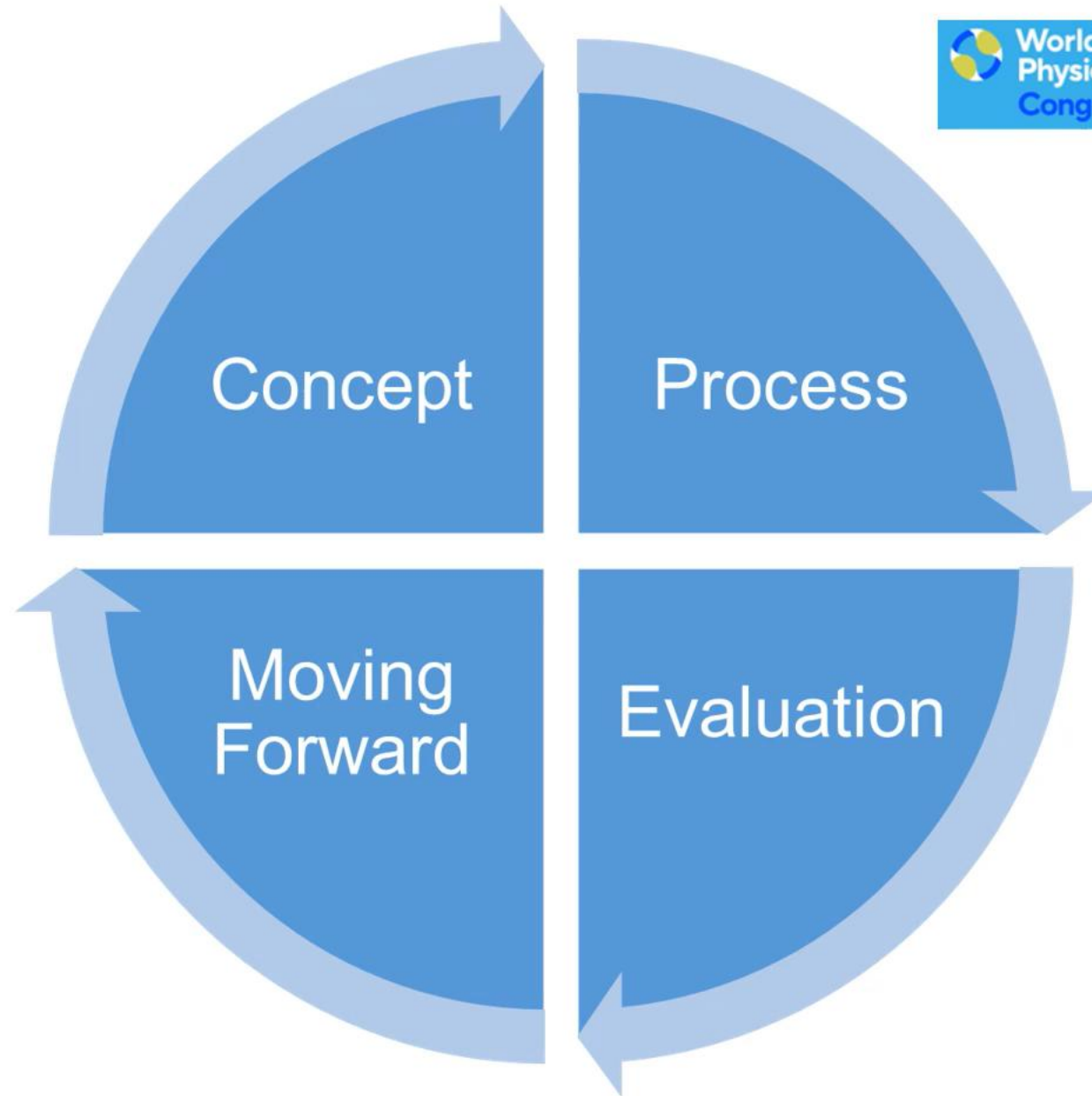

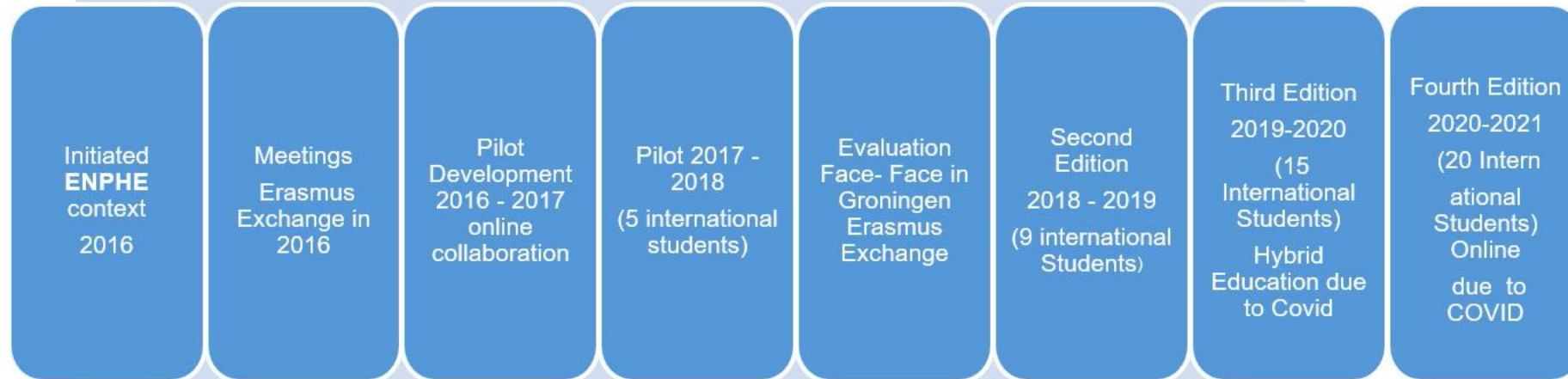

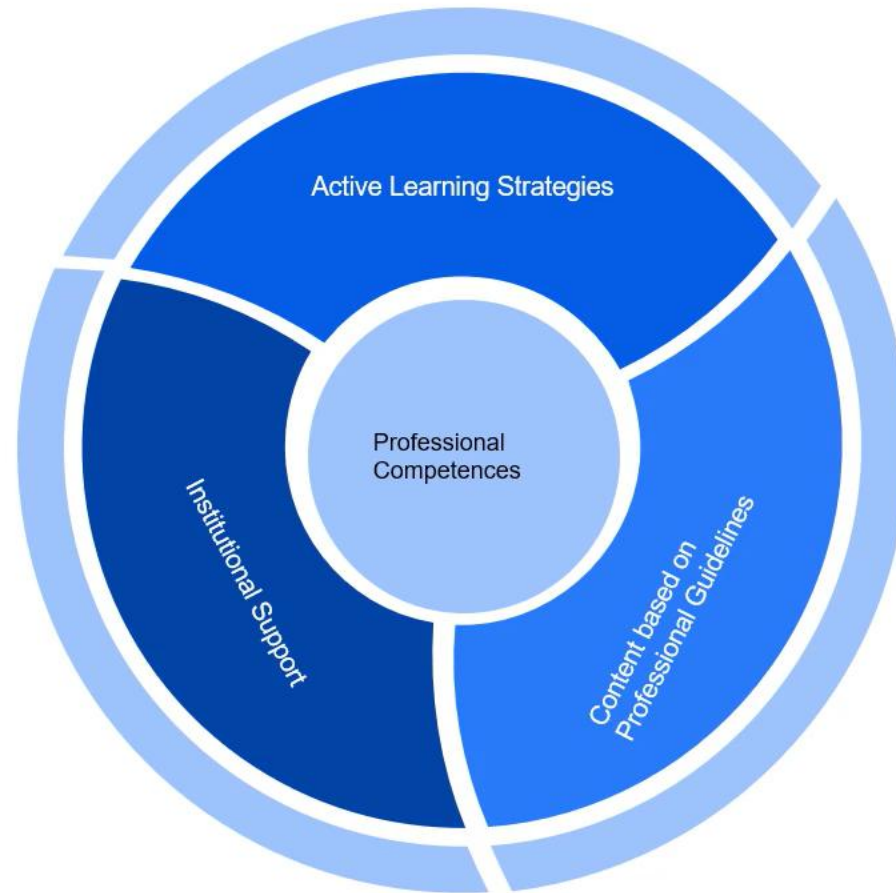


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Process Timeline

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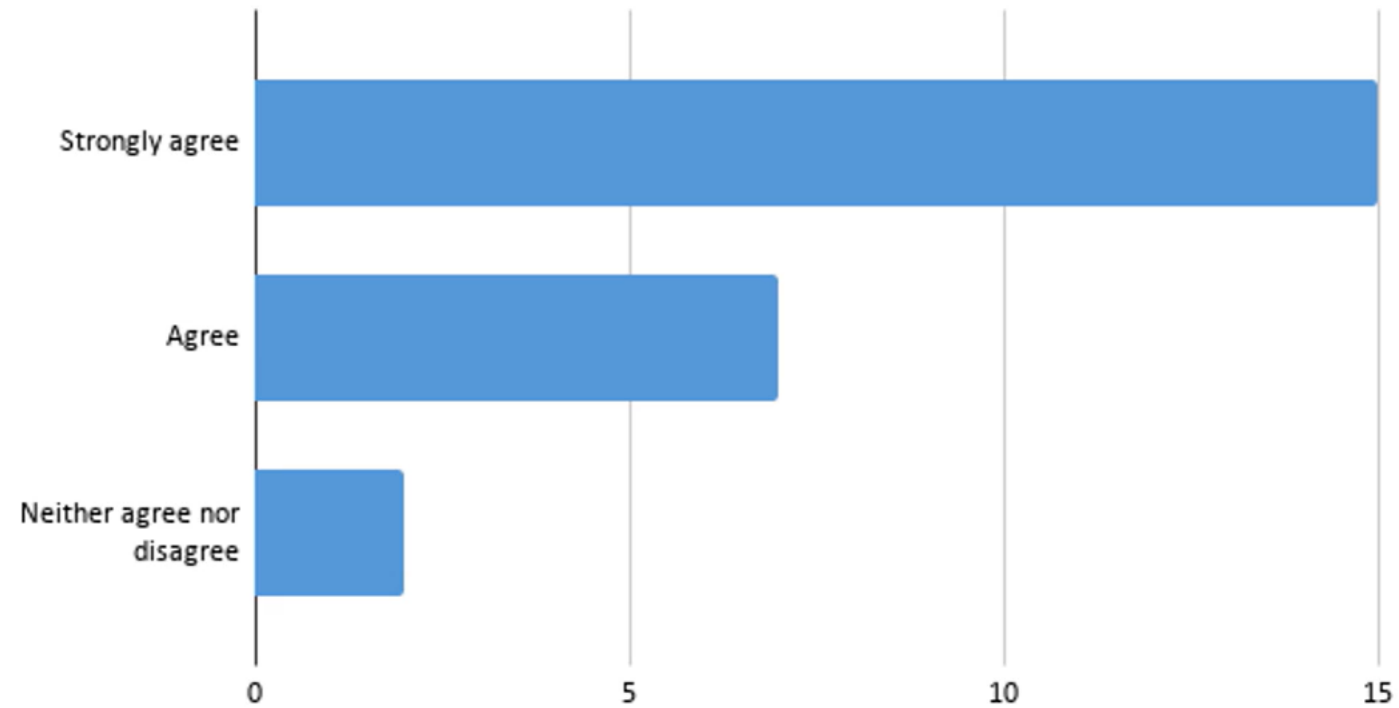

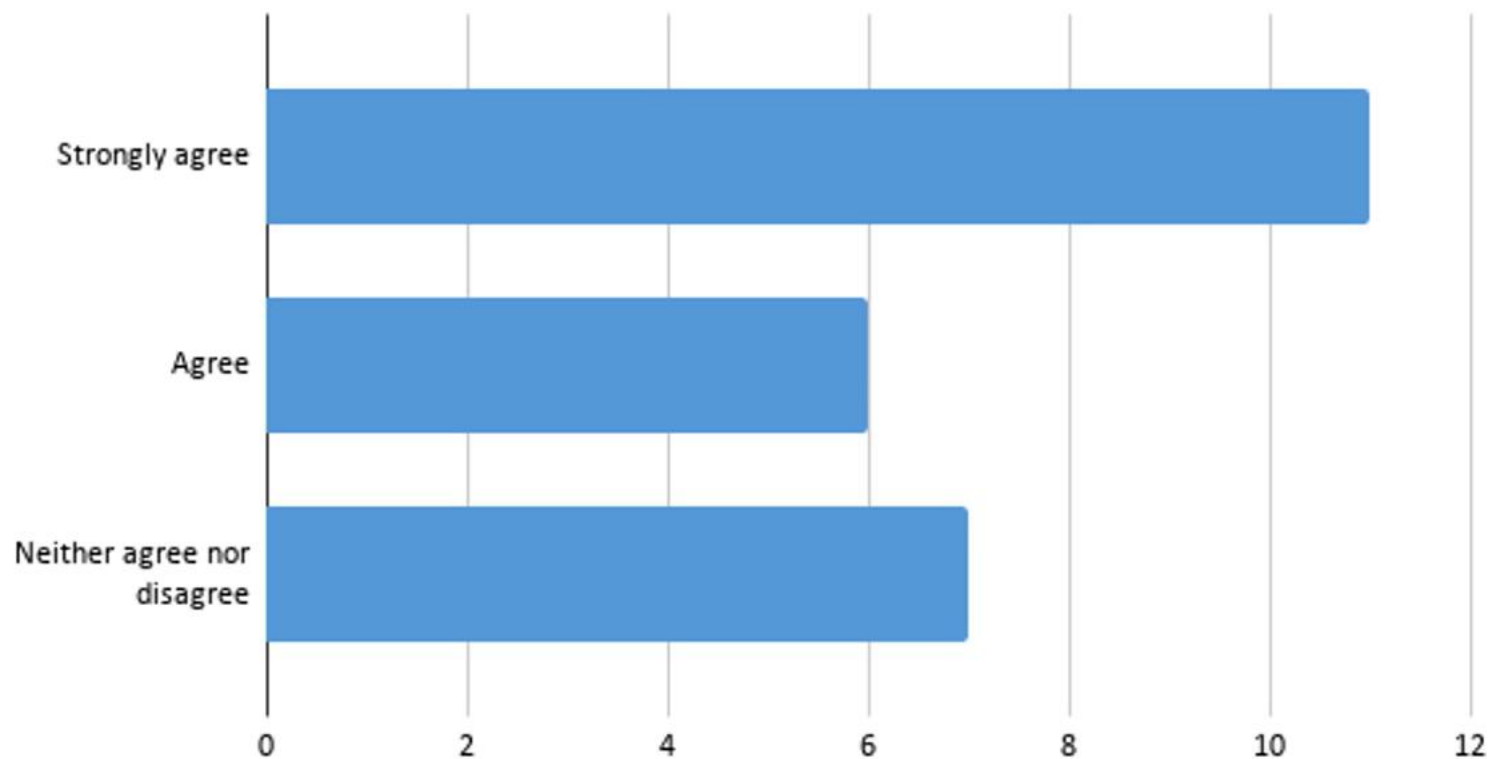

Promoting Physiotherapy competences in Acute Conditions In Specific contexts Along life cycle

The acute care settings relates to the care provided to a patient during an acute illness, an acute exacerbation of a chronic illness/disability or a surgical intervention which necessitates admission to an acute care facility.

Physiotherapy is an important intervention that prevents and mitigates adverse effects of immobility and recumbence during critical illness. Rehabilitation delivered by the physiotherapist is tailored to patient needs and depends on conscious state, psychological status and physical strength.

Educational environment

Modules will have an international team of teachers with expertise in the different fields and contexts of acute care for teaching and coaching both presential and online. Also to provide experiences in real context, students will be able to visit and follow patients under supervision of clinical practitioners in acute care units.
